At its monthly meeting Wednesday afternoon, the School Board of Miami-Dade County unanimously approved a resolution by District 7 Board Member Lubby Navarro, recognizing the week of May 16-22, 2015 as National Safe Boating Week.

The National Safe Boating Council (NSBC) embarks every year on a public awareness campaign as part of the National Safe Boating Week. The event is normally scheduled to commence a week prior to Memorial Day weekend in order to educate communities across the country about the importance of safe boating practices, and specifically about wearing a life jacket while on the water with a goal of preventing unwarranted deaths due to drowning.

“Wearing a life jacket while on the water is of utmost importance to ensure the safety of all children and families in our community,” said School Board Member Lubby Navarro.
